Office Order

Whereas, M/s Bochem Healthcare Pvt. Ltd. (hereinafter referred to as "the firm") participated in Tender Reference Nos. UPMSCL/Drugs-067/235, UPMSCL/Drugs-192/036 and UPMSCL/Drugs-208/52 floated by Uttar Pradesh Medical Supplies Corporation Limited (hereinafter referred to as "UPMSCL");

And whereas, upon evaluation of the bids submitted by the firm, it was declared eligible and Letters of Intent (LOIs) bearing Nos. 529/UPMSCL/Drugs/LOI/2021 dated 17.06.2021, 962/UPMSCL/Drugs/LOI/2023 dated 09.10.2023 and 1163/UPMSCL/Drugs/LOI/2024, dated 12.11.2024 were issued in its favour;

And whereas, pursuant to the aforesaid LOIs, the firm submitted the following Performance Bank Guarantees (PBGs):

1. BG No. 0035NDLG00006428
2. BG No. 0035NDLG00006435
3. BG No. 10894PFBG372496

And whereas, subsequent to issuance of Purchase Orders under the aforesaid tenders, certain batches supplied by the firm were declared "Not of Standard Quality" by Government laboratory.

In order to recover the respective penalty amount as per tender conditions, UPMSCL initiated proceedings for forfeiture/encashment of the Performance Bank Guarantees furnished by the firm, details whereof are reproduced below:

And whereas, upon verification and request for encashment by UPMSCL, both ICICI Bank and SBI Bank informed UPMSCL that the aforesaid Performance Bank Guarantees submitted by the firm were forged/fake;

And whereas, submission of forged/fake Bank Guarantees constitutes a "fraudulent practice" within the meaning of Section III, Clause 25(ii) of the tender document, which defines fraudulent practice as any act or omission, including misrepresentation or submission of forged/fake documents, intended to obtain financial or other benefits or to avoid obligations under the tender process or contract;

And whereas, a Show Cause Notice bearing No. 136/UPMSCL/DRUGS/LOI/2026-27 dated 15.05.2026 was issued to the firm calling upon it to explain the circumstances relating to submission of forged/fake Performance Bank Guarantees and to submit its reply within seven (7) days;

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And whereas, the firm submitted its reply through email dated 20.05.2026 stating inter alia that the situation had arisen due to "unavoidable banking and financial complications" and not due to any deliberate or mala fide intention;


And whereas, the explanation submitted by the firm has been duly examined by UPMSCL and found unsatisfactory, untenable and unacceptable in light of the explicit provisions of the tender conditions;

And whereas, the repeated submission of forged/fake Performance Bank Guarantees by the firm across multiple tenders clearly establishes deliberate misrepresentation and intentional involvement in fraudulent practices, thereby violating:

1. Section III, Clause 25(ii) – Fraudulent and Corrupt Practices; and
2. Clause 13(iv) – Debarring & Blacklisting, which stipulates that any bidder/supplier submitting forged documents in tender proceedings or subsequent correspondence with UPMSCL shall be declared ineligible to participate in tenders for a period of five (5) years.

Now therefore, in exercise of powers conferred under the applicable tender conditions and procurement provisions of UPMSCL, M/s Bochem Healthcare Pvt. Ltd. is hereby debarred and blacklisted from participating in any present and future tenders/procurements of Uttar Pradesh Medical Supplies Corporation Limited for a period of five (5) years from the date of issuance of this Order, on account of its involvement in fraudulent and corrupt practices, including submission of forged/fake Performance Bank Guarantees.

Further, UPMSCL reserves the right to initiate any other legal, civil and/or criminal proceedings against the firm, as may be deemed appropriate under applicable law.
